

Peep Inside our Stories ...

... and Bring Out a New One!

Contest rules and regulations:

1. Steps to follow to enter the contest

- Purchase a minimum of 10 different fiction readers for the students in the group (a group will consist of 10 students).
- Send the group's project by e-mail together with the completed registration form and a copy of the receipt to the to the following address: <u>bookshop@uniscan.ro</u>.

2. Contest Challenge

- Organise groups of 10 students within the same segment (primary/ lower, secondary/ high school).
- Each participant of the group choses a favourite character of the story they read. There should be 10 characters in total in the new story. For this, each participant presents his/her favourite character and the group will decide by vote who will be the main characters and the side characters. Keep in mind that each chosen character brings with him/her the message of the story he/she comes from.

• Use all 10 characters to write a new story. Make sure to follow the requirements:

<u>Primary school</u>: students' projects should be designed on A4 format paper (word or pdf format if you'd like to include illustrations); number of pages: 4; correct meanings of the words.

<u>Lower/upper secondary:</u> students' projects should be designed on A4 format paper (word or pdf format if you'd like to include illustrations); number of pages: 6; accurate grammar structure.

Each group should use the template we provide and send us back the story.

3. Evaluation and prizes

- The winning coordinating teachers will receive a useful Resource book.
- The winning students will receive a free digibook code of a reader. They will be able to access the digital reader on any device (laptop/desktop, smart phone, tablet) through Express digibooks platform (https://expressdigibooks.com). Each digital reader also provides an audio-visual dictionary, a collection of additional cross curricular activities as well as captivating videos that support and extend the topic of the reader.
- Certificate of Project Coordinator will be awarded to all coordinating teachers.
- All contestants will receive a diploma of participation.
- Evaluation period: between 1st June-10th June.
- The winners altogether with the winning stories will be announced on 10th of June 2024 on our website www.uniscan.ro (Kids' Projects) and by contacting the coordinating teachers.

PRIZES:

We will organise a raffle to select 7 winning stories.

MORE PRIZES:

There will be **3 more prizes** accorded to **3 stories** for the following categories:

- 1. The most humorous story
- 2. The touchiest story
- 3. The most surprising plot twist
